REMINDERS

<u>Halloween Party:</u> The party will be <u>tomorrow</u>, <u>October 31st at 2:00 pm</u>. Students may dress in <u>orange</u> and black. Please, no costumes or face paint. *Thank you so much to all of the parents helping with the party!*

<u>Reading logs:</u> Reading Logs for October are **due this Wednesday**. The reflection on the back of the calendar needs to be done as well.

3rd grade Mass: The 3rd grade is leading the Thanksgiving Mass on Wednesday, November 15th at 8:35 AM. Please let me know if your child will not be there.

Book Report: The students will be assigned their first book report today. They will be making a **Story Wheel** that shows important story elements from their book. They are to choose a fiction book (preferably 200 pages or less). It can be a book that they are already reading, but not one that they have already read. Your child will be given the instructions for the book report tomorrow and also a rubric, which I will use when grading them. This report is due on **Wednesday, November 29th.**

Geography Quiz: Last week we finished our Geography unit, there will be a short quiz next Thursday, November 9th. A study guide will be coming home with your child tomorrow.

<u>Prayer to the Holy Spirit</u>: Students have been reciting The Prayer to the Holy Spirit. This prayer will need to be memorized by **Monday**, **November 6**th. Your child can also recite the prayer to me before this

date, if they are ready. They can recite the prayer to me before school, after school or at recess.

CURRICULUM

<u>Math:</u> We take a subtraction assessment and then move on to problem solving. This week we focus on looking for key words and information to help solve word problems.

Reading: Today and tomorrow we read and perform several short Halloween plays about bats, spiders, and pumpkins! Students will practice reading aloud in front of the class with excellent expression. This week we read chapter 8, our target skills are cause and effect and setting.

<u>Science:</u> This week we will continue to study life cycles. Students will start to learn about polar bears and their life cycle. Students will also review animal adaptations with a Halloween-themed reading activity

Social Studies: We finish making our Geography lapbooks. We will have a geography quiz next Thursday.

<u>Language Arts:</u> We finish our descriptive Fall poem. Students begin working on writing a personal narrative about something that has happened in their life. This week students will pick an event to write about and brain storm ideas.

Religion: We will briefly talk about **All Saints Day** and **All Souls Day**. We will also finish our "Family Showing Care" comic strips and share in class. Then, students will work in groups of 3 for Unit I review. We will have a unit test on Friday, Nov 3, 2017 (before going to church for adoration

Spelling: The homework is due Thursday and test will be Friday. Our pattern this week is *unexpected consonant spellings*.
