### This week we will be:

**Reading**: Students read the informational text Mountains: Surviving on Everest. They search for informational text features.

<u>Math</u>: Students took the 7s test today. They also learn the 8 facts and will be test next Monday on them. We continue to work on measurement chapter. This week we focus on telling time to the minute and elapsed time.

**Language Arts:** We finish our Native American writing.

**Religion**: Students learned about our Creed. We will continue to work on Apostles' Creed mini-mural. Students will start to memorize the Apostles' Creed prayer.

**Science:** This week will begin by reviewing the steps of the Engineering Design Process. Students will act as transportation engineers to examine intersections and how they work. They will use observations to help inform safety decisions when modifying the intersection.

**Second Step:** We will wrap up our unit on Empathy. We will review how focusing attention and listening to others can help students make conversation. Students will then learn about making conversation to help make friends and get along with others.

<u>Social Studies</u>: Students learn about supply and demand. We go through different scenarios and students have to decide what will happen to the price of certain items when demand or supply change.
