### This week we will be:

**Reading:** We continue reading Ramona Quimby. This week we read chapter 2 and talk about character traits.

<u>Math:</u> Students take the 11s test today and are introduced to the 12 facts. We also continue our study of area. This week we find the area of composite figures.

**Social Studies:** We research our states for the State in the box project.

**Science:** Students will come up with two individual designs for their Maglev train system this week. They will then work in groups of four to share ideas and combine them into one design plan.

**Religion:** Students will memorize the Apostles Creed prayer. They will also continue to work on their Passion Stories. We will also discuss about the Eucharist, our highest form of worship.
