We encourage you to find ways for your children to earn the money to donate as well by completing chores, etc. This is a great leadership opportunity for our class and a chance for students to live out Catholic social teachings.

# CURRICULUM

<u>Math</u>: This week we will begin Chapter 5: Understanding Division. Students will practice hands-on division and focus on the concept of division as equal sharing. We will also look at division as repeated subtraction.

**<u>Reading:</u>** We will read chapter 10-11 of The Boxcar Children this week.

<u>Science</u>: Students will finish learning about polar bear habitats, food, body, and behaviors. We will then conduct an experiment to learn about polar bear adaptations.

<u>Social Studies</u>: We begin our next unit on culture. We read about culture and what it is. Then students will have a chance to pick a country to learn more about.

<u>Religion</u>: We will discuss the **Seasons of the Liturgical Year**, beginning at **Advent** and ending at **Christ the King Sunday**. Children will learn about the **Advent Wreath**, the symbol used during Advent season.

**Second Step**: We will continue our empathy unit this week by talking about conflicting feelings. Students will learn how empathy helps us notice when others' feelings are the same or different than our own.

**Spelling**: The assignment is due Thursday, and the test is on Friday.
