# Curriculum

**Reading:** We will continue reading *Ramona Quimby*. This week we will read Chapter 3 and focus on cause and effect.

<u>Math</u>: Students learned the 11s facts today and will be tested on these next Monday. This week we will begin our geometry chapter.

<u>Language Arts</u>: This week we will use our Language Arts time for PLTW and a Mother's Day project.

**Science:** Students will begin to plan and create their Maglev transportation system this week. They will have a budget of 50 dollars and each train has to transport eight "people" and travel about 12 inches.
