## Curriculum

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**Math:** This week we will wrap up subtraction with an assessment on Tuesday. We will then begin Chapter 4: Multiplication. Students will learn about multiplication as repeated addition.

**Reading:** We will read chapter 4 of *The Boxcar Children* this week. We will focus on reading with good fluency and expression.

**Social Studies:** Students will take a test on the Pacific region states and postal abbreviations on **Thursday.** We will continue to work on our geography notebooks.
