Reminders

Priority Application Period:

November 15th is the close of the priority application period. Do you have a 2020/2021 Kindergartener or New Preschooler? If you have an incoming Kindergarten or **new** to the Preschool student that you would like to enroll into Holy Rosary School, applications are now due. **All** Kindergarten students must have an application submitted. Social Studies Homework:

Book Report:

By now, students should have chosen their book and should be reading it. There is no November Reading Log so students can focus on their book reports. The report is due on Thursday, December 5th.

Items Needed:

Any small, thin plastic tubs similar to ones berries or veggies come in and small, empty tissue boxes (square/cube style) to use in our science unit.

Curriculum

Math: We will continue to work on problem solving this week. Students will work through different strategies to help them solve multi-step word problems.

Reading: We will begin reading Chapter 9 in the *Boxcar Children*. We will use an app on the iPads called ChatterBox to share character traits.

Language Arts: Students will complete their Best Part of Me writing this week. They will then work on a self-reflection on their learning so far this year.

Social Studies: Students will create a Pic-Collage about Ellis Island. We will also share our immigration postcards.

Science: This week, students will continue learning about hermit crabs, specifically what they eat and their body parts. Students will then be introduced to the hermit crab challenge, an opportunity to construct their own crabitats, or habitats for the hermit crabs to explore. Students will have the opportunity to choose various items to complete their design plan and then they will observe hermit crab behavior and change their crabitat plans accordingly.

Religion:

3rd graders will learn about the Eucharist as the most important form of prayer. We will go over the parts of the Mass.

Spelling:

The assignment is due Thursday, and the test is on Friday.
