Reminders

Curriculum

Reading: We will read "The Kamishibai Man." We will focus on how the mood changes throughout the story. We will also focus on the target skill of cause and effect.

Math: Students took their 5s tests today and were introduced to the 6 facts. They will not be tested on **6s until Monday, February 24**. This week we will wrap up Chapter 10: Fractions. Students will spend two days reviewing concepts and will take the test on Thursday.

Science: We will have a brief lesson on density and students will conduct several Valentine's Day experiments with candy hearts this week.

Social Studies: We continue to study the Native American regions. We read and write about the Northwest Coast and Great Plains.

Religion: 3rd graders will continue to write and illustrate the Parable of the Prodigal Son. They will discover the moral of the story: God loves us no matter what.

Language Arts: Students will work on editing their clothing paragraphs and will begin taking notes for their food paragraph this week.

Spelling: The assignment is due on Thursday and the test is on Friday.
