WHAT WE'RE LEARNING

READING: Students will read, "Bat Loves the Night" and work on sequencing events.

LANGUAGE ARTS: We continue learning about the different types (statements, questions, commands, & exclamations) and practicing cursive.

SCIENCE: We will wrap up our unit on animal life cycles.
