#### WHAT WE'RE LEARNING:

**READING:** Students read and respond to the first two chapters of <u>The Boxcar</u> Children. We are loving this story!!!

**LANGUAGE ARTS:** We continue to working with subjects in sentences and continue using the 4-Square method in our writing.

MATH: We finish chapter 2 and take short addition assessment. We begin chapter 3 digit subtraction.

**SCIENCE:** We continue to learn about inherited traits and learned behaviors.

**SOCIAL STUDIES:** We continue our study of landforms and bodies of water.

RELIGION: Students learn more about Mary, our heavenly mother who is a model for our families. Students are encouraged (optional) to pray the Creation Novena that is posted under Activities in Seesaw.

# Important Information:

<u>MAP Testing:</u> Our next MAP test will be on Monday <u>afternoon</u>. It will be the reading section, which typically takes 45-90+ minutes, depending on the student. Remember, students may not have direct assistance with the test. Parents can help my making sure students stay on track, as this test in particular is long and can be challenging. If a student needs a brief stretch/water break mid-test, that is fine--and encouraged.

Students will report to <u>homeroom</u> at 12:30 on Monday. Teachers will give instructions and help the students access the testing codes.

When finished with MAPs: There is a list of assignments that students need to complete. These will be self-paced, but should be completed by the end of the day on Monday. Students may begin these once they have finished the MAPs test (after taking a break). We are asking students to post to Seesaw so we can make sure they are completing this checklist.

<u>Lunches of Love:</u> Third graders are assigned October as our month to prepare sack Lunches of Love. This is an ongoing, school-wide service project. Lunches should be non-perishable: Items that make good lunches include nuts/trail mix, fruit cups, protein bars, individually packaged chips/crackers, Vienna sausages, jerky, ritz cheese/crackers (shelf-stable only), and a plastic spoon/fork. WATER is the drink of choice. Lunches can be dropped off at the school office at any time. They will be taken to the parish office and distributed to those in need.
