MAP Testing: Our final fall MAP test will be on **Friday morning (October 23rd)**. It will be the Language Arts section, which typically takes 30-60+ minutes, depending on the student. Remember, students may not have direct assistance with the test. Parents can help by making sure students get logged on. If a student needs a brief stretch/water break mid-test, that is fine--and encouraged.

Students will report to homeroom at 8:30 on Friday. Teachers will give instructions and help the students access the testing codes.

Students will report back to their HOMEROOM class at 10:00am.
