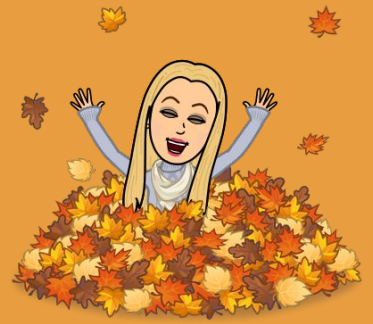

WHAT WE'RE LEARNING:

READING: Students will read chapters 7-8 in the Boxcar Children. Our target skills are cause/effect and setting. Children should be reading at least 20 min per night and marking off their Nov. calendar. See information in today's email if you're interested in ordering books from Scholastic. Paper flyers were sent home in the reading packet with the new supplies. These books will be here before Christmas!!

LANGUAGE ARTS: We finish our unit on combining sentences and constructing compound sentences. We will also write cinquain poems about autumn.

MATH: We finish chapter 4 on multiplication and take our assessment.

SCIENCE: We learn about weather and climate in the "Stormy Skies" unit from Mystery Science.

SOCIAL STUDIES: We learn about Ellis Island and begin making a Pic-Collage about what we learn.

RELIGION: We begin Ch. 5--this chapter explains how we worship as Catholics and the special place of the Eucharist among the Seven Sacraments.

→ **Prayer Memorization:** Students should have the "Come, Holy Spirit" prayer memorized by the end of this week. An extra copy was included in the religion packet with the new supplies. Ms. Corrigan will have students recite this prayer aloud (*individually or in front of the class*) on Friday.
