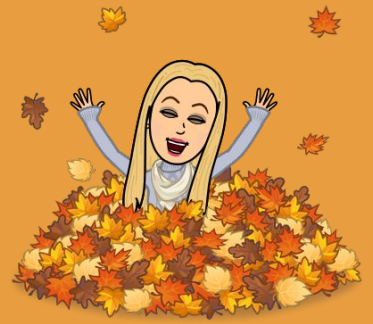




3rd Grade Newsletter

SEESAW:

Parents, please take some time to look at your child's Seesaw portfolio with your student. Please post the following assignments if you have not already:

Math: subtraction assessment and page 146 in math book

Reading: Boxcar Children Ch. 4 worksheet

LA: Pet Essay Final Draft, Grammar Packet pages 19-20

Religion: Wednesday Mass reflection

Science: Inherited Traits and Learned Behaviors in Animals

Social Studies: physical geography, climate, natural resources activity

WHAT WE'RE LEARNING:

READING: Students will read chapters 5 & 6 in the Boxcar Children, focusing on character traits as well as cause & effect. October reading logs are due! I will have students complete the back side in class on Monday and post during class time. It might be helpful for students to have one of the books from their Oct. log with them in class (optional) to refer to as we complete the back of the log. All children should be reading at least 20 minutes per night (some of that really should be out loud) from a book of their choice. Students have November logs in the reading section of their files. Let's read every day!

LANGUAGE ARTS: We continue to work on predicates in sentences and editing run-on sentences.

MATH: We begin chapter 4 on multiplication. This week we learn how multiplication is repeated addition.

SCIENCE: We finish our unit on inherited traits and learned behaviors.

SOCIAL STUDIES: We review the pacific region states and learn a new section of states in our GeoJourney.

RELIGION: We celebrate All Souls' Day on Monday and pray for those who have gone before us. We finish Ch. 4: The Holy Trinity in our religion book. Students will take an open-book test on Tuesday. Please pray the "Come Holy Spirit" prayer every night aloud.
