#### <u>This week we are learning:</u>

**READING NOVEL UNITS:** Students are enjoying our novel units. Some students are reading Mr. Poppers Penguins with Mrs. Meland and Ms. Arciaga and some are with Ms. Corrigan reading The Boxcar Children. This week, our target comprehension skills are: using context clues and sequencing main events. Students will remain with these same novel groups throughout the unit. Ask your child about the book they are reading!

READING LOGS: Students should reading 20 minutes a night and marking the October log. Students should be reading at least ONE fiction chapter book this month. Hang on to those logs! The backside will be completed as a separate assignment at the end of the month, at which time students will write about the characters and setting in this chapter book. Mrs. Wallace, our school librarian has been helping students select books to check out and either take home or keep at school. In addition, each child has a book box containing books they have chosen to read during silent reading times.

**LANGUAGE ARTS:** We review what adjectives are and practice using them in our writing.

<u>MATH:</u> We review subtraction with regrouping and across zeros.

<u>SOCIAL STUDIES:</u>: We continue our study of geography. This week we learn about the different bodies of water.

**SCIENCE:** We finish our unit on animal life cycles.

**RELIGION:** We learn about the Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary and practice the "Come Holy Spirit" prayer. Please make sure your third grader is practicing at home.
