Summer Work:

Later this week we will be sending via email reading and math packets, as well as ideas for other summer work. Please be on the look out for this information.

Summer Pen-Pal Writing: I would like to invite all third graders to participate in our Summer Fun Pen-Pal Program. 50 States Test:

Students will have their **final state test tomorrow!** The test will cover all 50 states and the abbreviations. Students will be given the names of the states and will have to label them on a map and write the abbreviation as well.

This week, we will be learning:

Math: Students write a survey question and collect data from the class. They will then report what they learned using a bar graph, pictograph and line plot.
