ANNOUNCEMENT/ REMINDERS

This week we are learning:

READING: Students read, "A Fine, Fine School" and learn about story structure. We build fluency through partner-reading activities.

LANGUAGE ARTS: We review different types of sentences and begin using our handwriting workbook.

MATH: We begin chapter 1 on place value. This week we will review the different forms you can write numbers in and also review comparing and ordering numbers.

SCIENCE: We will go over science expectations and decorate our science notebooks.

SOCIAL STUDIES: We will go over social studies expectations and begin our study of geography.

RELIGION: We will review Mass expectations and responses.
